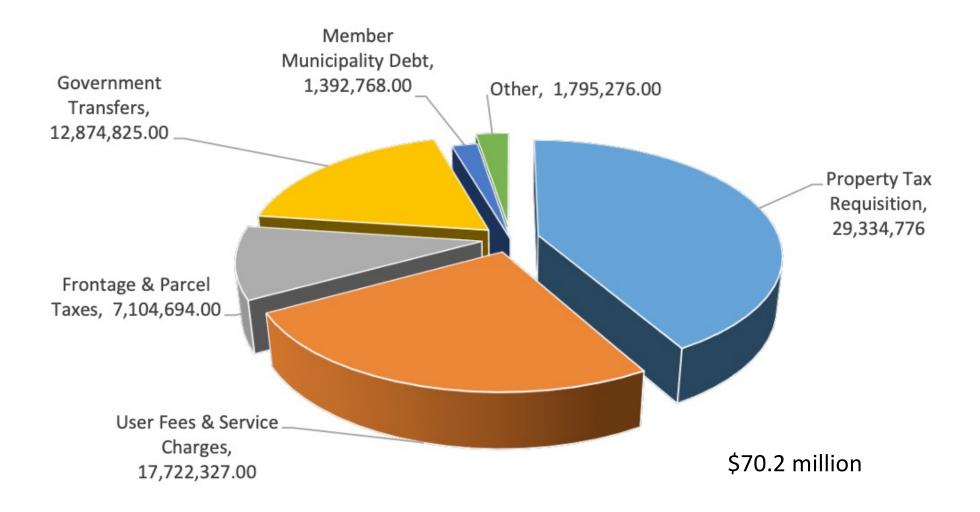

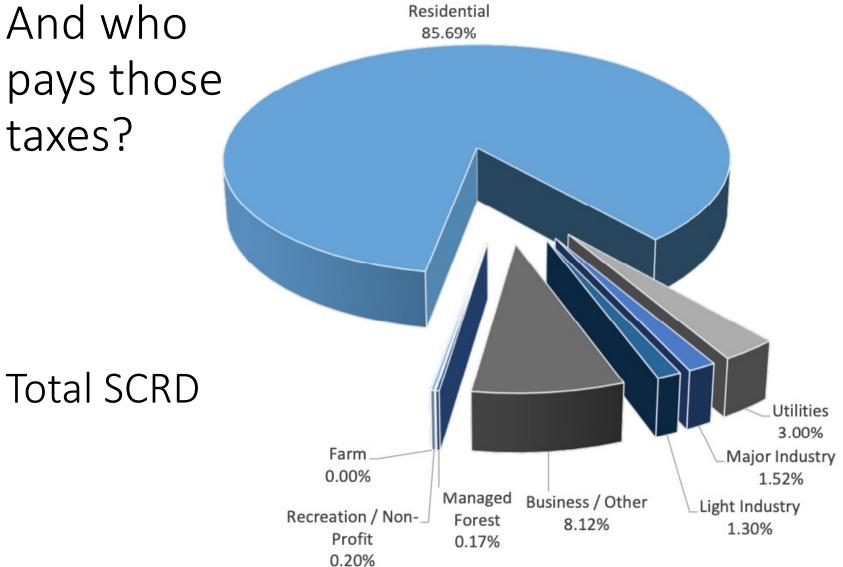

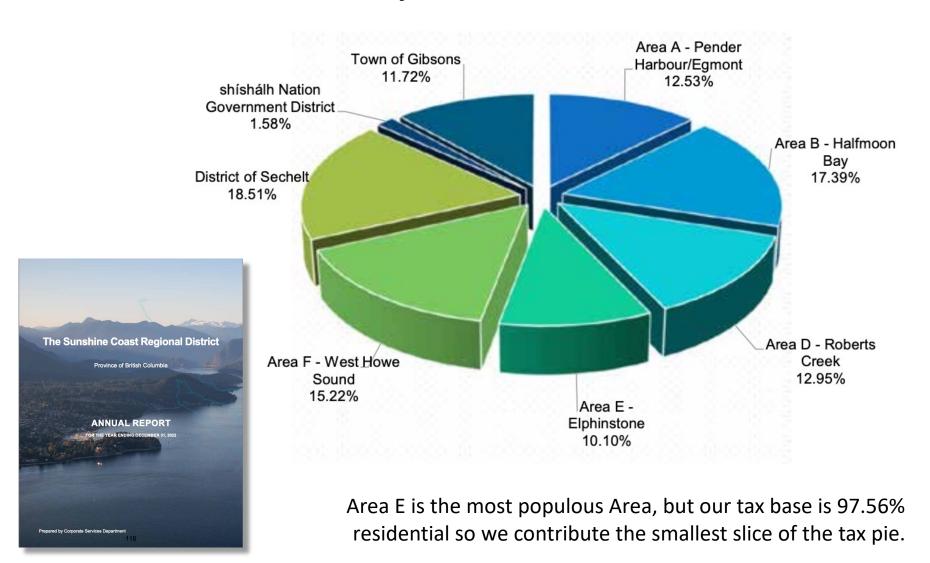
SCRD Sources of Revenue



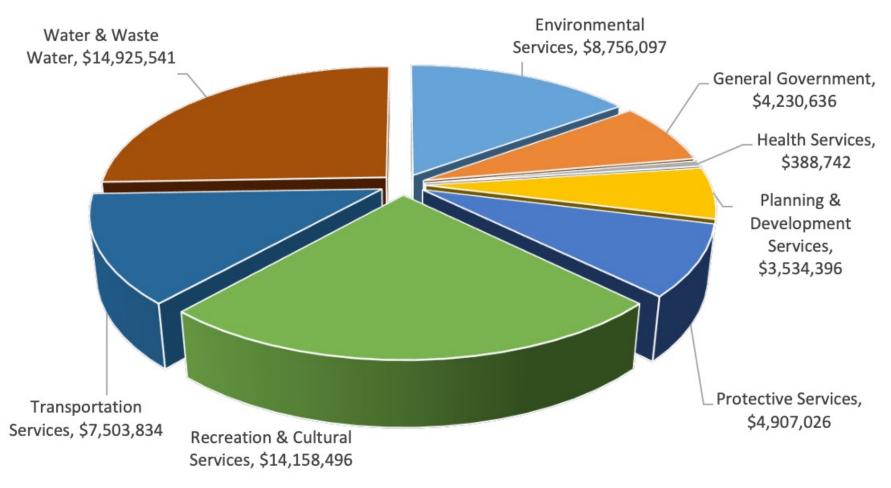
And who pays those taxes?



Taxes by Area - 2022

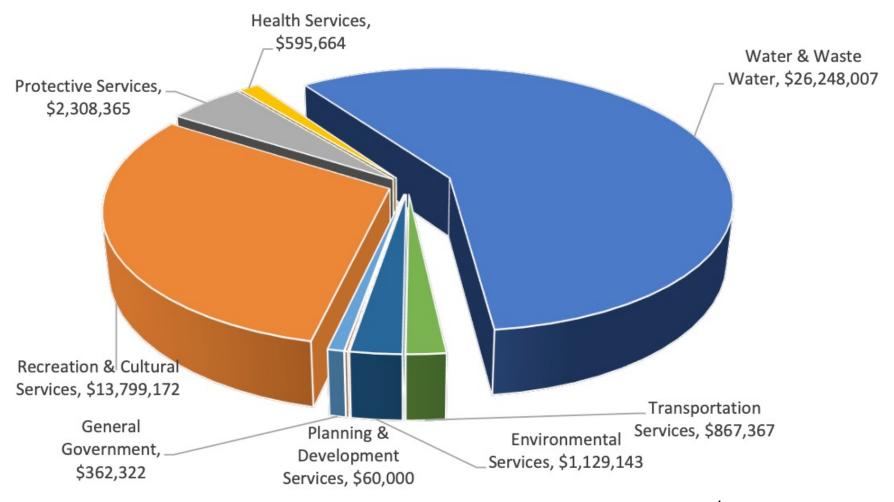


SCRD Operating Expenses

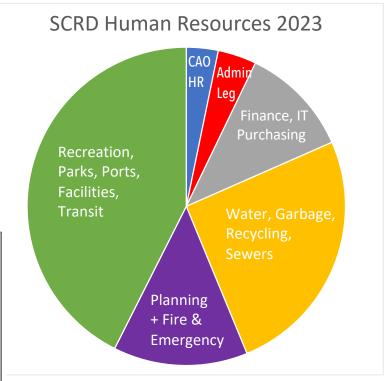

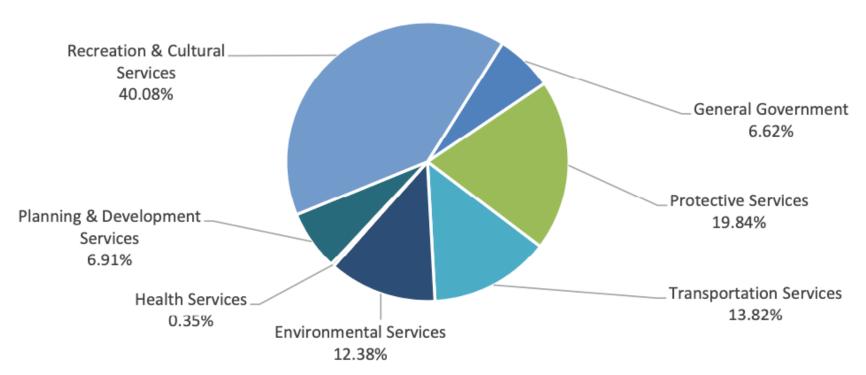

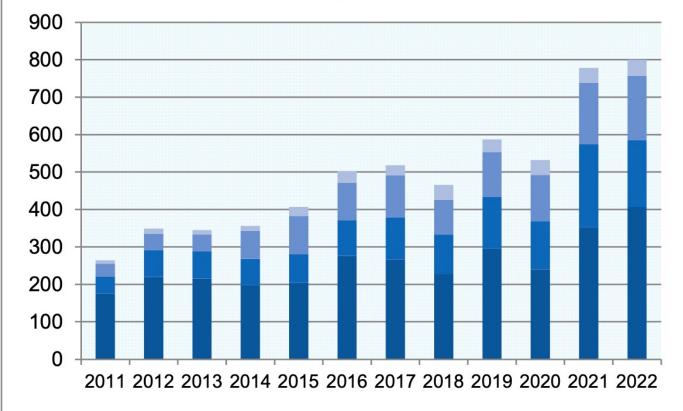
