Dear Mr. Waksel,

On behalf of the residents of Elphinstone (SCRD Area E), who the ECA represents, we are very pleased to see the repair to the "S" curve on Gower Point Road nearing completion. However, we wish to inform you that numerous residents have also asked us why no provision was made for cyclists and pedestrians. Although some residents tried to get information through your offices or Capilano Highways, as far as we know there was no consultation with the community regarding design requirements.

Because no space was included for active transportation, the reconstructed road is now significantly more dangerous for pedestrians and cyclists. The previous poor condition of the pavement forced a degree of caution on vehicle operators. What drivers now see is brand new pavement built for them. Pedestrians have nowhere to walk or run but on the pavement, and with no shoulder there is no escape from a careless driver. Cyclists have no choice but to ride in the center of the traffic lane regardless of speed.

Since many cyclists and pedestrians rely on Gower Point, and it is now much less safe for them, we reluctantly conclude that this much needed project has a fatal design defect. Because MoTT's own website indicates that modern design standards incorporating active transportation are part of your mandate, we further contend that any design process that doesn't include the safety of all road users by default is itself a defective process.
